#### Rock around the clock!

- infrastructure...
  - ...is best when you don't recognize it
  - ...is required 24x7
  - ...has to be dynamic, scaleable and stable
  - ...enables the community to do magic
- "provides the playground"

#### It takes two...

### hosted directly at TDF

- mailing lists, websites, wiki, Pootle, help, MirrorBrain, rsync, CMS, WebDAV, OTRS, blog planet, Torrent tracker, AskBot, forum, Gerrit, extensions, OpenGrok
- 7 servers and up to 29 VMs
- external services
  - FreeDesktop.org: git, BugZilla, mailing lists
  - Isolahoodi blog, VoIP PBX, mirror network

#### 133713371337

- team of 15 administrators from 5 countries
- **7** TDF servers, up to **29** VMs, plus external services
- **TDF** alone handling up to **10 TB** of monthly traffic
- 100 mirrors worldwide
- 122 mailing lists in 35 languages, ~1.000 MB
- 18,000 subscribers, half of them for announcements
  in total, over 250 GB of web-hosted data at TDF



#### Born free

- all based on free software
- all knowledge to be within the community
- development of own infra products
  - Puppet modules
  - PyMIME
- contributing back to other projects



#### Houston, we have a problem!

- mixture of Ubuntu 10.04 LTS and 11.10
- different models of server hardware
- Infra needs to keep pace with community
   → organic growth to provide services in time
- need to restructure the current setup
  - involve new admins, spread knowledge
  - centralized and documented configuration
  - same hardware and OS basis

#### Rock me, baby!

- Ubuntu 12.04 LTS as primary system
- migrating MySQL to PostgreSQL
- LXC containers on top of LVM
- isolation of services for security reasons
- propagating IPv6 connectivity
- HA with failover and loadbalancing
- distributed storage using Gluster
